# Ōtorohanga College Uniform

*For start of 2010 school year*

A uniform is worn to encourage a spirit of identity and pride in our College. All uniform items are according to a specific regulation design and pattern and there are to be no variations on the theme. Students are expected to wear the College uniform correctly during school hours, to and from school and at school functions when required. If they choose not to wear the correct uniform a series of consequences will be enforced. All items of uniform should be clearly named.

## GIRLS' UNIFORM:

1. Navy skirt made in regulation "Somerset" fabric colour "Midnight". Own choice of pattern with length around the knee.  
*Or:* Regulation "Gamma" style navy trousers worn to ankle length.  
*Or:* Regulation "Miltan" style navy shorts.
2. Navy or white socks with trousers.  
Plain coloured stockings (either black, navy or flesh coloured).
3. *Either:* Plain dark brown or black Roman sandals worn with heel strap and without socks or stockings.  
*Or:* Plain, low-heeled, black leather lace-up shoes with black laces.  
N.B. Lace-up shoes are mandatory in the workshop.
4. Regulation light blue shirt with College emblem.



### **BOYS' UNIFORM:**

1. *Either:* Regulation "Miltan" style navy shorts.  
*Or:* Regulation "Gamma" style navy trousers worn to ankle length.
2. Regulation navy socks with gold and maroon bands.
3. *Either:* Plain dark brown or black Roman sandals worn with heel strap and without socks.  
*Or:* Plain, low-heeled, black leather lace-up shoes with black laces.  
N.B. Lace-up shoes are mandatory in the workshop.
4. Regulation light blue shirt with College emblem.



### **ADDITIONAL CLOTHING:**

1. Ōtorohanga College jacket in maroon / navy / gold.
2. Ōtorohanga College navy polar fleece.
3. Regulation V-necked maroon and gold jersey or a maroon sweatshirt.
4. In cold weather students may wear the regulation maroon and gold scarf.
5. **Plain navy** sun-safe hats may be worn outside the classrooms in hot sunny weather for health reasons in Terms 1 and 4 only.
6. The regulation College beanie may be worn outside the classrooms in Terms 2 and 3 only.
7. Short sleeved T-shirts worn visibly under the uniform must be **white**.

### **OTHER UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:**

1. The only jewellery which may be worn are plain studs or small sleepers, only in the ear and one plain finger ring. If a student needs to wear other jewellery for cultural or religious reasons, this must be out of sight and worn beneath the shirt.
2. In Physical Education students must get changed into suitable sports clothing. This includes shorts, navy if possible, with no outside pockets, no denim and a plain coloured shirt.
3. Neatness, tidiness and cleanliness are required. Male students should be cleanly shaven.
