Uniform Regulations

- Navy blue, ankle length trousers
- Navy blue shorts
- Navy blue, knee length skirt
- Light blue shirt with College emblem
- Navy blue thermal
- Navy blue polar fleece with College emblem
- Navy blue jacket with a gold stripe and College emblem or Paladin jacket
- Plain navy beanie may be worn outside the classroom in Terms Two and Three only
- Plain navy cap may be worn outside the classroom in Terms One and Four only
- Navy with gold and maroon bands or black ankle socks
- Navy, black or flesh coloured stockings
- Black, low heeled shoes, below the ankle
- Black, below the ankle sandals with a heel strap
- The only jewellery which may be worn is plain studs or small sleepers

Process

Students are expected to wear the College uniform correctly during College hours, to and from College and at College functions when required.

If a non-regulation item of uniform is worn staff will ask for the item to be removed or to sight a dispensation.
